

Health PPE Portal Update

Since its launch, the [Health PPE Portal](#) has provided personal protective equipment (PPE) and critical supplies to general practitioners, nurse practitioners and physician specialists in community clinics across B.C.

If you have already ordered through the portal, you will soon receive an email reminding you of your unique customer identification number and inviting you to place your next order for up to three months of PPE and critical supplies. Reordering is available starting June 1, 2022. Please note – hand sanitizer is out of stock and will not be replenished.

If you do not receive an email by June 15, 2022, or if you have yet to order from the portal and are eligible, please email health.ppe@gov.bc.ca for assistance.

Due to significant order volumes, please allow for 12-15 business days to receive your delivery.

Please note that if you work in both a health authority clinic and a private community clinic, you are still eligible to access PPE for your private community clinic through the portal.
